

# *A View of Navarro County*

## **Art Contest Guidelines**

- The contest will be judged in three divisions:
  - A. Elementary School
  - B. Middle School
  - C. High School
- Winners will be selected in each division with **Savings Bonds** being awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and ribbons for Honorable Mention.
- All dimensional and media forms of artwork are acceptable. Two-dimensional entries shall be no larger than 20" x 24".
- Judging will be based upon creativity and originality as well as design (composition, balance, unity, proportion) and skill in executing the medium. Judges will also consider relevance to the theme, "A View of Navarro County."
- All artwork must be matted and ready to hang.
- Each entry must have a clearly printed 3" x 5" card attached to the back. The following shall be printed on the card: student's name, telephone number, school, teacher's name, and division entered.

- Applicants are solely responsible for the delivery and return of contest entries.
- Entries will be accepted until Friday April 18, 2008. The exhibit will open on Wednesday April 23, 2008.
- Winning entries will be announced during the reception for the young Artists Exhibit to be held on Wednesday April 23<sup>rd</sup> from 4:00 pm to 5:15 pm at the Warehouse Living Arts Center.
- Entries will be displayed from April 23 – May 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Warehouse Gallery. Artwork may not be removed before the close of the exhibit.
